Sealed bids will be received by the City of Lancaster in the office of the City Controller 2nd FL, 120 North Duke Street, Lancaster PA 17602 until 11:00 a.m. on March 22nd, 2017 and will then and there be publicly opened and read aloud in The Mayors Conference Room.

Project generally comprises of base repairs and milling and overlay of various streets, construction of handicapped ramps, installation of storm water inlets, and restoration to areas disturbed by construction operations.

Notice is hereby given to bidders that this project is funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and is subject to the Davis-Bacon Act of March 3, 1931, as amended, and wages must be paid by contractors according to the U.S. Labor Department's Wage Decision included in the specifications; provisions of Section 3 of the Housing Act of 1968; the President's Executive Order 11246 or any other order which prohibits discrimination in employment. All bidders must comply with the requirements of the Federal Labor Standards

Bids security of 10% of bid is required.
