The City of Lancaster is seeking bids for

CONTRACT: #2017-13, titled Stormwater and Water Projects Chesapeake, Broad, and Chester Streets

Sealed bids will be received by the City of Lancaster in the office of the City Controller 2nd Fl, 120 North Duke Street, Lancaster PA 17602 until 11:00 a.m. on September 13, 2007 and will then and there be publicly opened and read aloud in the Mayors Conference Room for

Project generally comprises of comprises the abandonment of a section of exiting water main and services and the construction of approximately 1,040 LF of various size DICL water main with new services to replace the older system in preparation for street paving projects, on Chesapeake Street between Circle Avenue and Franklin Street, and Chester Street Between Lime and Shippen Streets. Storm water aspects of the project comprises installation of approximately 140 feet of 36 inch PVC storm sewer across the 400 Block of South Broad Street in the City of Lancaster. Work will involve installation of the new storm water pipe under various existing utilities, installation of a new manhole, and connection to an existing manhole approximately 15' deep. All storm water project work is to be completed by 40 days from Notice to Proceed.

Bids security of 10% of bid is required.

Bids may not be withdrawn after the time set for bid opening.

Copies of Bidding Documents may only be obtained at the Owner's Office of Procurement and Collection, 39 West Chestnut Street, Lancaster, PA, 17603 for a fee of \$50.00 per set. Deposits will become the property of the Owner and no deposits will be returned. All shipping fees will be the responsibility of the purchaser.
