The City of Lancaster is seeking bids for

CONTRACT: #2017-14, titled CONSTRUCTION OF GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE PRACTICES

Sealed bids will be received by the City of Lancaster in the office of the City Controller 2nd Fl, 120 North Duke Street, Lancaster PA 17602 until 11:00 a.m. on October 4, 2007 and will then and there be publicly opened and read aloud in the Mayors Conference Room for

Project generally comprises of construction of four green infrastructure stormwater control projects to reduce stormwater runoff and combined sewer overflows throughout the City. The projects will include the construction of permeable pavers, infiltration systems (trenches and beds), and vegetated systems (rain gardens and bioretention). Work included, but is not limited to, repaving existing parking areas, installing subsurface aggregate infiltration systems, installing permeable pavers, installing various drainage elements (catch basins, cleanouts, piping, etc.), and installing bioretention areas. Landscaping work may include planting of new trees and other vegetation. These projects will be awarded through a unit cost, quantity-based bid. Construction is expected to start by November 15, 2017.

Pre-Bid Scheduled for September 26, 11am in City Commission Room, 1st Floor, City Hall. This meeting is not mandatory.

Bids security of 10% of bid is required.

Bids may not be withdrawn after the time set for bid opening.

Copies of Bidding Documents may only be obtained at the Owner's Office of Procurement and Collection, 39 West Chestnut Street, Lancaster, PA, 17603 at no cost. All shipping fees will be the responsibility of the purchaser. Electronic Delivery is the preferred method for this project.
