

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

The City of Lancaster is seeking bids for  
**CONTRACT: #2016-14, titled Eastbrook Road Water Main Loop Project**

Sealed bids will be received by the City of Lancaster in the office of the City Controller 2<sup>nd</sup> Fl, 120 North Duke Street, Lancaster PA 17602 until 11:00 a.m. on November 9<sup>th</sup>, 2016 and will then and there be publicly opened and read aloud in the Mayors Conference Room.

Project generally comprises the construction of approximately 2,515 LF of 16" DICL water main, 300 lf of horizontal directional drilled PVC, and new services ahead of a PennDOT project on Eastbrook Road. The work shall include the installation of fire hydrants, valves, appurtenances, and restoration to areas disturbed by the construction operations. The project will involve work on Eastbrook Road between Old Philadelphia Pike and Siegrist Road.

Copies of Bidding Documents may only be obtained at the Owner's Office of Procurement and Collection, 39 West Chestnut Street, Lancaster, PA, 17603 for a fee of \$85.00 per set. Deposits will become the property of the Owner and no deposits will be returned. All shipping fees will be the responsibility of the purchaser.

Bids security of 10% of bid is required.

Bids may not be withdrawn after the time set for bid opening.
