**INTRODUCED – FEBRUARY 9, 2016**

**ADOPTED BY COUNCIL – FEBRUARY 23, 2016**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER AMENDING THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER AT CHAPTER 55, OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES, BY FIXING THE SALARY OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER FOR THE FOUR YEAR TERM BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2018.**

**WHEREAS**, the Office of the Mayor of the City of Lancaster for the four year term beginning January 1, 2018 will be filled by the election to be held in November 2017, and it is deemed to be in the best interest of the City that the salary of said Mayor for the four year term beginning January 1, 2018 be fixed at this time; and

**WHEREAS**, the Office of the Mayor of the City of Lancaster is a full-time position.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED** by the City Council of the City of Lancaster as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The Code of the City of Lancaster, Chapter 55 – Officers and Employees, Article V – Mayor, Section 55-21, Compensation, is hereby is amended as follows:

A. The annual salary of the Mayor of the City of Lancaster, who will be elected at the municipal election to be held in November of 2017, be and the same is hereby fixed as follows:

Calendar Year Beginning January	Salary per Annum
2018	\$85,000
2019	\$86,275
2020	\$87,569
2021	\$88,883

...

C. All appropriation ordinances for the years 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2021 shall fix the salaries

of the office of Mayor as provided above.

**SECTION 2.** The provisions of this Ordinance are severable, and if any section, sentence, clause, part or provision hereof shall be held to be illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision of the Court shall not effect or impair the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, parts or provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the City Council of the City of Lancaster, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, that this Ordinance would have been enacted if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional section, sentence, clause, part or provision had not been included herein.

**SECTION 3.** Any and all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith shall be and hereby are repealed.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance shall take effect and be enforced in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
