**COUNCIL ORDINANCE NO. 14 – 2015**

**COUNCIL BILL NO. 14 - 2015**

**INTRODUCED – OCTOBER 13, 2015**

**ADOPTED BY COUNCIL – OCTOBER 27, 2015**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER ENACTED PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY SET FORTH IN SECTION 285-130.E. OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, CHAPTER 285, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC; ESTABLISHING A TEMPORARY EXCEPTION FROM THE HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACE LIMITATION SET FORTH IN SECTION 285-130.B TO PERMIT THREE (3) HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACES ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE 700 BLOCK OF HIGH STREET; AND PROVIDE THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL EXPIRE UPON THE EXPIRATION OF TWO YEARS AFTER ITS EFFECTIVE DATE UNLESS REENACTED BY COUNCIL.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Lancaster (the “City Council”) enacted Chapter 285-130 with the intent and purpose of limiting exceptions from the limitations of handicapped parking spaces in appropriate situations; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that it is appropriate to exclude the north side of the 700 block of High Street (near 757 High Street) from the limitation on the number of handicapped parking spaces located on each side of the street set forth in Section 285-130.B, in order to accommodate a resident with visual and physical impairment; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to provide a sufficient number of handicapped parking spaces upon the north side of the 700 block of High Street, City Council desires to adopt this Ordinance to allow the Administrator to establish up to three (3) handicapped parking spaces on the north side of the 700 block of High Street.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED** by the City Council of the City of Lancaster, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania as follows:

**Section 1.**

The north side of the 700 Block of High Street shall not be subject to the limitation on the number of handicapped parking spaces that may be established under Section 285-130.B.

**Section 2.**

The Administrator may establish up to three (3) handicapped parking spaces upon the north side of the 700 block of High Street.

**Section 3.**

This Ordinance shall expire and be of no further force and effect after the expiration of two (2) years from the effective date hereof, unless reenacted by City Council. The Administrator shall notify City Council, the Traffic Commission and each Applicant on the 700 block of High Street no more than 90 days and no less than 60 days prior to the expiration hereof.

**Section 4.**

This Ordinance shall take effect and be enforced in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
