PUBLIC ART PROJECTS

(HL/WT) Central Market Visibility Project

- 7/6/16 New details being worked out regarding brackets and installation methods. Meetings with Marketechs, Matt Metzler and Bob Demarias have taken place. HL met with Metzler and Cindy McCormick to inspect and see brackets raising concern over weight and installation method. Metzler and Demarais (who is offering work pro bono) identified three problem areas and solutions. Marketechs have picked up materials and is working toward correcting installation as provided in the form of signed engineered drawings from Demarias. No new installation date at this time.

- 9/7/16 The goal is to have the signs installed to coincide with the conclusion of the streetscape renovations which are poised to be complete by Central Market Harvest Breakfast (beginning of October)

(LM/DaS) Litter Letter Project

- 8/3/16 No meeting
- 9/7/16 Letter Letters have been returned to the New Holland Pike Recycling Center for display until a new proposal is received. Approximately \$1,000 remains from the original LCSWMA grant for an additional project. Public Art intern, Lizzy, is working on a potential partner at F&M.

(HL) Display Cases

- 7/6/16 Second exhibition is set to be installed on 7/12 from 9-11 am (Toy Train Museum, North Museum, Lancaster Science Factory, and Lancasterhistory.org). Working to gather proposals from other organizations who have expressed interest to plan future exhibition schedule. PAAB agrees that HL can oversee selection of organizations.

- 9/7/16 Discussion of possibility of artist installations in cases at the recommendation of Renee P. Recommendation by HL and AR is to move forward with museums participating as is through January, receive final master plan document, and begin planning for potential case for artist installation.

- 8/3/16 No meeting
- 9/7/16 Sign structure layout, content and designer proposal was shared. Sign quote was reviewed. The board approved moving forward. NL and HL will continue to work on image gathering and will bring concepts by designer to the board for feedback and approval.
- (AR/HL) **Public Art Master Plan**
- 7/6/16 Survey reached 364 responses, 88% of responders did not attend a public meeting showing that we were able to reach a broader audience. Next consultation visit will be on 7/19, 4pm, at the Marriott on Penn Square with exact room TBD. PAAB members are encouraged to take the Partners & Success survey.
- 8/3/16 No meeting
- 9/7/16 Received feedback from July 19/20 visits. RP and JMc are working to build out the plan. Suggested that PAAB and committee continue to review plan remotely and use RP for future event to present plan to the public.

- 7/6/16 HL followed up with ArtBridge after internal review with CK. The proposal seems to have a good structure with flexibility. WT will revive and take over committee from KH and will review next steps and committee members.
- 8/3/16 No meeting
- 9/7/16 Committee has been revived and will meet in September to review ArtBridge plan.
- (NL/MN) **Board Onboarding Communications**
- 9/7/16 HL sent final draft of onboarding materials to the PAAB for review. Feedback was positive and committee will move forward with publication of materials.
- (HL) **City Hall Gallery**— Emily Adleblute, Lancascapes, small to medium sized landscape paintings are on display through October. Next exhibit for November is to be Lancaster Country Day School students.

PRIVATE PUBLIC ART PROJECTS

DID/Lancaster Alliance artist designed bike racks: Committee met with artist, T.J. Drier. Reviewed two designs reflecting modifications from the original design. Ken Hammell is still active as an advisor to this project.

Lafayette Mural: Mural is installed and the ribbon cutting is 9/8 at 9:45 am. Mayor will attend.

Poetry Paths: Installation of Poetry Path at Penn Square has begun and will be completed with the resolution of the streetscape project. Everything is on track. Tentative date of September 30 for dedication.

Fall ArtWalk: Community engagement art event is to take place at LOOP. Discussion of large scale coloring page murals featuring images from David Ramsay Jr.'s coloring book of Lancaster City as activity.

The Strangers Project: A temporary, traveling, public art event has submitted a permit application and is approved to set up at Central Market on Tuesday, September 13.
