PUBLIC ART PROJECTS

(HL/WT) **Central Market Visibility Project**

10/5/16 Signs are being installed. Will happen over the course of the next couple of weeks.

(AR) **Our Identities Unedited: The Lancaster Sound Map**

10/5/16 Exhibition is happening at Millersville University Winter Center through October 6. We received a PCA grant for \$1096 for the encore performance. We will need to raise additional funds and plan the event. HL and AR met and will begin to plan location and may be reaching out for help from board for promotional assistance.

(HL) **Litter Letter Project**

10/5/16 F&M proposal was approved by the board. Litter Letters are to be installed at F&M on 10/14. Several college organizations are working to collect recyclables prior to install date so they can color code the letters. Libby Modern is working on a sign mock up to place near the letters to educate viewers on the project. ReThink stickers are being printed by Blacksmith Printing for hand out on campus.

(HL) **Display Cases**

10/5/16 Planning for Jan 2016 install. Railroad Museum, Landis Valley Museum, Rockford Plantation to participate.

(NL) **MLK Elem. School pool renovation**

10/5/16 Modern Art provided 3 drafts of design. HL and NL are discussing and will work to present a final draft to the board.

Poetry Paths: Dedication was on 9/30. Barbara Buckman Strasko read the poem along with three young poets from SDoL. Kerry Sherin Wright, of F&M Writer's House, spoke about the value of art and poetry in the city.

Fall ArtWalk: Community engagement art event is to take place at LOOP. Discussion of large scale coloring page murals featuring images from David Ramsay Jr.'s coloring book of Lancaster City as activity.

The Strangers Project: A temporary, traveling, public art event took place at Central Market on Tuesday, September 13. It was well received and ran smoothly. This was a great example of how low-cost, temporary public art projects can be encouraged to happen through well explained and promoted permitting process.
