(HL/WT) **Central Market Visibility Project**

12/7/16 King and Market Street locations installed. Final location at Orange and Market Streets traffic signal install date is TBD. Waiting on manufactured bracket.

(AR) **Our Identities Unedited: The Lancaster Sound Map**

12/7/16 Received PCA grant for \$1096 which will be divided into two mini grants for local artists to create work based on the Lancaster Sound Map. RFP is written and being reviewed by Megan Blackman. This will be posted once review is complete.
