Water Plant Supervisor – Susquehanna Plant

Primary Function

This is responsible supervisory work in directing all operations of a Water Treatment Plant. An employee in this class is responsible for all operations of a single water treatment plant, including training, directing, operations, and maintenance and recommending to the Superintendent staffing and budgeting. The employee is also responsible for associated equipment to that plant such as, but not limited to, pump stations, water storage tanks and valve houses. Matters of policy are determined by, and general supervision is received from, the Superintendent of Water in matters relating to water production and maintenance. The employee exercises considerable independent judgment in carrying out assigned responsibilities and is held accountable for achieving desired results.

Training and Experience

- Graduation from a four-year Engineering or Management program is highly desirable and five years experience in the operation and maintenance of a water treatment plant, including two years management experience in operation of a water treatment plant.
- Any equivalent combination of training and experience.

Licenses and Certificates

- Possession of, or ability to obtain within two years, a Class A, Type I, Waterworks Operator Certificate issued by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- Possession of a valid driver's license as issued by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Comments

- Requires lifting up to 50 lbs.
- Requires standing outdoors for long periods.
- Works around motorized or moving equipment and machinery.
- Requires working long hours and must be available to handle emergency situations after hours, weekends and holidays.
