

STATED MEETING - CITY COUNCIL – JUNE 25, 2013

A meeting of the Lancaster City Council was held on Tuesday, June 25, 2013 in Council Chambers, Southern Market Center, 100 South Queen Street, Lancaster, PA, at 7:30 p.m., with President Williams presiding.

City Council led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

City Council approved the minutes of June 11, 2013 by a unanimous roll call vote.

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE – Ms. Wilson stated that the Committee met this evening before the Council meeting to discuss a resolution which is on the agenda and she will go into detail when it comes up.

Administration Resolution No. 35-2013 (the title) was read by the City Clerk as follows:

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER
AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION SEEKING FUNDING
FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE (DOJ) FOR THE FY2013 BYRNE
JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM.**

Councilman Urdaneta made the motion to approve and Councilman Graupera seconded.

Ms. Wilson stated that earlier this evening Captain Schmidt came to Committee and explained about the federal grant that comes through the County. Through that grant allocations are made to the City which allows the Police Bureau to purchase 1 new patrol vehicles and 3 mobile data terminals for in the police vehicles. City Council approved Administration Resolution No. 35-2013 by a unanimous roll call vote.

COUNCIL COMMENT - Councilman Roschel stated that he is a member of the Lancaster County Community Foundation, they are starting to take applications now, so if Council knows of someone who might be interested, please let them know. He further stated that he had occasion to go buy Rodney Park and if you measure success by the smiles on the children's faces, the renovations are a great success.
