Sealed bids shall be delivered to the City of Lancaster, office of the City Controller 2<sup>nd</sup> FL, 120 North Duke Street, Lancaster PA 17602 up until 11:00 a.m. On August 14<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at 11:00 a.m. the bids will then be publicly opened and read aloud in The Mayors Conference Room, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor.

The project generally consists of site work, playground demolition and construction, pool demolition and construction, site amenities, lighting, stormwater, and recreational facilities.

Bids security of 10% of bid is required.

Bids may not be withdrawn after the time set for bid opening.
