

**PUBLIC NOTICE**  
**#2020-18 MAPLE GROVE SEWAGE PUMPING STATION**  
**AND INTERCEPTOR EXPANSION**  
**CITY OF LANCASTER, PA**

The City of Lancaster, PA will receive sealed bids online for Maple Grove Sewage Pumping Station And Interceptor Expansion for the Bureau of Wastewater until Friday, October 30, 2020 at 11:00AM at which time they shall be opened electronically and publicly posted on PennBid's website. The upgrade to the pumping station shall include: three 3,265 gpm pumps with 250 hp, 1800 rpm motors and VFDs; three slide gates; channel grinder; wet well baffles and splitters; discharge plug and check valves; flume installation (at Wastewater Treatment Plant); conversion of an existing generator room to an electrical room; exterior generator in a standalone enclosure; HVAC system; new PLC and controls; and demolition of existing equipment to accommodate new work.

The Expansion to the interceptor shall include: the replacement of approximately 3,600 LF of 24-inch to 30-inch sanitary sewer main; approximately 2,340 LF of 18-inch to 24-inch sanitary sewer main and approximately 300 LF of 24-inch to 24-in sanitary sewer main. Work will include temporary bypass pumping and maintenance of flows. This project will contain (5) Primes to be bid upon: General, Electrical, HVAC, Plumbing and Interceptor. There will be a Mandatory Pre-Bid held On October 1, 2020. More details about the Mandatory Pre-Bid can be found in the bid documents. This project is being funded, in part, with federal funds. Contractors are required to demonstrate the Six Good Faith Efforts to identify and solicit DBE firms for procurement of project construction, equipment, services, and supplies.

All bidders must insure that employee and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, creed, color, ethnic or national origin, sex, age, or religion.

Notice is hereby given that this Project is funded by the Pennsylvania Infrastructure Investment Authority (PENNVEST), subject to the Davis Bacon Act of March 3, 1931, as amended , and that wages must be paid by contractors according to the U.S. Labor Department's Wage Decision (a copy of which is included in the Specifications), and Federal Executive Orders 11625, 12138 and 12432. It is also subject to EPA Regulations located at 40 CFR Part 33 requiring the detailed documentation of solicitation of disadvantaged business enterprises.

The City of Lancaster, PA reserves the right to reject any and all Bids and to accept the Bid, which is in the best interest of the City. The lowest responsible bidder need not be the bidder submitting the lowest dollar amount bid. The City may also consider the quality of the goods or

services supplied, ease of repair, compatibility with other City equipment, responsiveness, past performance of the bidder and any other reasonable factors specified in the bid package.
