The City of Lancaster, PA will receive sealed proposals online for City of Lancaster Advanced Wastewater Treatment Plant Switch Gear and Transformer Upgrade Project for the Bureau of Water until Wednesday, February 10, 2021 at 11:00AM at which time they shall be opened electronically and publicly posted on PennBid' s website. The work is generally described as the demolition and installation of two 15kV switch gear line ups, replacement of four medium voltage transformers, and replacement of medium voltage cabling so as to upgrade the same at the Lancaster Advanced Wastewater Treatment Plant located at 1220 New Danville Pike, Lancaster, Pennsylvania.

There will be a Mandatory in-person Pre-Bid Meeting held on Wednesday, January 13, 2021. More details about the Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting can be found in the proposal documents.
