**#2021-08 CONSTRUCTION OF 24" WATER MAIN LINE IN EAST
HEMPFIELD TOWNSHIP**

The City of Lancaster, PA will receive proposals online for the Construction of 24" Water Main Line in East Hempfield Township until May 12th, 2021 at 11:00AM at which time they shall be opened electronically and publicly posted on PennBid's website. The City of Lancaster is seeking bids from qualified contractors to construct and install approximately eighty-eight (88) linear feet of twenty-four (24) inch DICL water main by boring under a railroad, to construct and install approximately seventy-five (75) linear feet of twenty-four (24) inch DICL water main by open cut and connection to an existing water main, flushing and disinfecting of approximately two-thousand, two hundred fifty-three (2,253) linear feet of existing twenty-four (24) inch DICL water main and restoration to all areas disturbed by construction operations, all within East Hempfield Township, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania.
